

Animate Pro sample material setup guide

Templates and sample files will be required for some of the lessons in the Animate Pro 2 Getting Started Guide. You must first install them, then follow steps to use them in your project.

Step-by-step installation

1. Go to the following web page:
toonboom.com/products/animatepro/eLearning/
2. In the Video Learning section, download the Sample Material package.
3. Once the package is downloaded, double-click on it to launch it.
4. Follow the installer's instructions.

To use the templates

1. Launch Toon Boom Animate Pro.
2. Create a new blank project.
3. In the Library view, click on one of the following 3 folders to view the sample material content:
 - Templates
 - Templates >
Undone_example_sample_material
 - Templates >
Completed_examples
4. Select a template from the right-hand side of the Library view.
5. Click and drag that template to the left-hand side of the Timeline view and drop it where the layers are ordered. You can also drop it directly in the Camera view.

The template now appears in both the Timeline and Camera views and is ready to be animated!

Files in the Library view

Here are the types of files you will find in the templates folder:

- Undone_example_Sample_Material
Prepared scenes to be completed during lessons in the Getting Started Guide.
- Completed_examples
The resulting scene files for completed lessons in the Getting Started Guide.
- Templates
Various elements that can be used to complete some of the lessons in the Getting Started Guide.
